He teaches weekly bird carving classes in Western Washington and his studio in Gig Harbor. The birds are carved from Tupelo; hard flight feathers, wings and tail are burned using a wood burner and fine burning tip; soft feathers are usually detailed with small ceramic stones. This is a complete bird, with carving, eye-setting techniques, blended acrylic washes, feet and legs and habitat. A very detailed power-carving project.
